LONDON REGION – STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES

2016 / 2017

- 1. Full Adult Training compliance with every adult who requires a first Wood Badge for their current role(s) to have them by 31/12/16**
 - WITHIN 3 MONTHS – CTM & LTMs in place and County Training Provision Plan agreed
 - WITHIN 6 MONTHS – Full programme of learning opportunities published and simple booking systems in place across all the Counties
 - WITHIN 12 MONTHS – All relevant adults who need a Wood Badge and who have held an appointment for over 3 years to have their Wood Badge

- 2. All Youth Sections with less than 5 members to be reviewed by 31/07/16 and an action plan for growth produced. All Groups with less than 12 members to be reviewed by 31/12/16 and leaders offered support, re-training or re-assignment**
 - WITHIN 3 MONTHS – A review to be undertaken of all Sections with less than 5 members and an initial Support Plan produced after a visit by the DC or their representative
 - WITHIN 6 MONTHS – A review to be undertaken of all these sections and a support plan agreed to help them increase their membership. A similar review then to be undertaken of Sections with less than 12 members and a similar Initial Support Plan produced
 - WITHIN 12 MONTHS – All of these Sections with less than 5 to have at least 10 youth members. Sections with less than 12 members to be on track to have 15 youth members

- 3. Missing Sections in each Group to be identified and action taken to open 50% of these within 12 months**
 - WITHIN 3 MONTHS – A review to be undertaken of all Groups with missing Sections and agreement reached with the CC & AGDM which of these will go into the workbank for development support
 - WITHIN 6 MONTHS – Work started in every District with missing Sections to open these
 - WITHIN 12 MONTHS – 50% of the Groups with missing Sections to have these opened or a clear plan in place to make this happen

- 4. Every Scout Group to have a 'Key 5 Objectives' review and a plan in place to achieve them**
 - WITHIN 3 MONTHS – An analysis to be done of the Scout Groups and a priority order agreed as to which Groups require a review first and these reviews to be begun by DCs & their Teams
 - WITHIN 6 MONTHS – 50% of all Scout Groups to have a 'Key 5 Objectives' sheet in place and action underway to achieve these items
 - WITHIN 12 MONTHS – 100% of Scout Groups to have a 'Key 5 Objectives' sheet in place and action underway to achieve these items

Underpinning all this full participation in the termly census, with the HQ Data Analyst Team turning these statistics into easy to use headlines and prompts to action
